

PRUNING

The letters **A, B & C** in the catalogue indicate the recommended method of pruning:

- A.** No regular pruning needed. When space is limited, immediately after flowering cut out all shoots that have flowered.

- B.** Cut out dead growth and weak shoots to a strong pair of buds in early spring (late March/early April in New England). Separate and train remaining growths.

- C.** Cut all shoots back hard in early spring to a strong pair of buds, removing the previous season's growth. This will normally be 9" to 18" from the ground, less for herbaceous varieties.
